Uniforms/Performance Attire

Used uniforms will be available for purchase at Back to Choir Night. Singers are responsible for purchasing, measuring, and shortening their own uniforms. If you have a uniform to sell, refer to the uniform information on the website. Please note: bring your checkbook to the used uniform sale. Checks will be the only form of payment accepted.

Volunteers Needed

Choir Coordinators

We are in need of Choir Coordinators for all of our choirs. These volunteers are required to attend every rehearsal for their choir, assist the director, help singers during rehearsals, answer questions from parents and other misc. duties. This special volunteer position offers a scholarship of ½ off the tuition for one singer. If you are interested in applying for a Choir Coordinator position, download the application from the website and send to the office by **August 18, 2010**. Note: because this job involves working with children, we are required to run a background check on all applicants.

Participation Guidelines

Below are the guidelines for participation in Angelica Cantanti:

Guidelines for Participation in Angelica Cantanti

Because the success of a choir is dependent on the full participation of each member of the choir, we expect singers (and their parents/guardians) to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Singers are expected to attend all rehearsals and performances except in cases of illness, school conflicts, or family emergencies. Parents must notify the choir office of any absences. Poor attendance may result in the child being asked to leave the choir.
2. Singers are expected to arrive on time and prepared to sing for all rehearsals and performances. Singers who arrive late or leave early miss important rehearsal time and disrupt the rehearsal for the other singers.
3. Parents must pick up their child promptly at the end of each rehearsal and performance.
4. Singers must exhibit appropriate behavior at all times.
5. Singers who decide to drop out of choir before the end of the season must inform the director immediately and turn in their music. Tuition and fund-raising profits will be forfeited.
6. Please review our new Attendance Policy posted on the website.

CANTABILE CHOIR TUITION

The Cantabile Choir tuition due for the 2010-2011 Angelica Cantanti season is \$475.00 + \$12 for 30th Anniversary T-shirt

The following are your payment options:

- 1) **Lump Sum:** If you wish to pay in a lump sum, please select that option on the tuition payment form below and mail your payment by **August 18, 2010**. If you prefer to pay by credit card, please contact Andrea in the choir office on how to proceed.
- 2) **Installment Plan:** You may request to pay tuition in 3 installments due August 16, September 15, and October 15. Please select that option on the tuition payment form below and mail the form, along with your first payment **due August 18, 2010**.
- 3) **Scholarships:** Based on financial need, you may request a scholarship toward your tuition. Please complete the Financial Assistance Application, which you can download from the website at www.angelicacantanti.org, from the Singer and Family page, click on the Choir Registration Page link. *Funds are limited, so please send in your application on time.* Mail your completed scholarship application by **August 18, 2010**.

Overdue Tuition Payments: It is your responsibility to make all tuition payments on time. Singers whose tuition is not paid in full (whether by lump sum, installment plan, or scholarship) by October 15, 2010 will be notified in writing that they cannot participate in rehearsals until their outstanding tuition is paid. ***There will be no exceptions to this policy.***
