Cantabile Rehearsals – NEW LOCATION!

We are looking forward to having you sing with Cantabile! Cantabile will rehearse on Mondays from 4:15 to 5:45 p.m. at the Bloomington Center for the Arts at 1800 W. Old Shakopee Road in Bloomington. The first rehearsal for the Cantabile will be Monday, September 12. Check the Cantabile Calendar link on the Angelica website for important dates.

Tuition

Back to Choir Night is a “one-stop” opportunity for you to turn in required forms, pay tuition, secure formal and informal performance attire pieces, check out Angelica spirit wear, learn about fundraising for your personal singers account and volunteer opportunities with Angelica, purchase a previous concert CD, meet and greet your director, say hello to old friends and meet some new friends!

Performance Attire

Used attire pieces will be available for purchase at Back to Choir Night. Singers are responsible for purchasing, measuring, and shortening their own items. If you have an attire piece to sell, refer to the performance attire information on the website. Please note: bring your checkbook to the used item sale. Checks will be the only form of payment accepted.

Additional Rehearsals

As we get nearer to concert performances, extra rehearsals will be necessary to ensure the success of the concert. We will try to get these rehearsals on the calendar as soon as possible. Email announcements will be sent out, but please bookmark this page and check the online calendar often for important changes.

Attendance Policy

Each singer is important to the sound of the choir and every rehearsal and concert performance is crucial to the success of the group. We rehearse just once a week and it is often accelerated - learning a lot of new music and instruction. If an absence is known in advance, an absence form must be completed and turned into the director no later than one week PRIOR to the absence. Absence forms can be downloaded and printed from the Angelica website.

Participation Guidelines

Below are the guidelines for participation in Angelica Cantanti:

Guidelines for Participation in Angelica Cantanti

Because the success of a choir is dependent on the full participation of each member of the choir, we expect singers (and their parents/guardians) to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Singers are expected to attend all rehearsals and performances except in cases of illness, school conflicts, or family emergencies. Parents must notify the choir office of any absences. Poor attendance may result in the child being asked to leave the choir.
2. Singers are expected to arrive on time and prepared to sing for all rehearsals and performances. Singers who arrive late or leave early miss important rehearsal time and disrupt the rehearsal for the other singers.
3. Parents must pick up their child promptly at the end of each rehearsal and performance.
4. Singers must exhibit appropriate behavior at all times.
5. Singers who decide to drop out of choir before the end of the season must inform the director immediately and turn in their music. Tuition and fund-raising profits will be forfeited.
