ANGELICA CANTANTI YOUTH CHOIRS—Celebrating our 38th Season, the Angelica program currently has 5 youth choirs and 1 adult/alumni choir called Encore. The organization provides high quality choral music education with artistic excellence in performance. The young singers include 320 members in grades 2–12 that come from communities from all over the Twins Cities. The choirs rehearse once a week, August—May at the Bloomington Center for the Arts.

ANGELICA CANTANTI CONDUCTORS



Michelle Gehrz is the Conductor of both Con Brio sections A & B. She currently teaches K-5 music and directs two choirs at Birchview Elementary School in the Wayzata School District. She is also the Co-Director of the Wayzata Elementary All-District Choir and directs an adult treble choir in the Twin Cities called Bella Lumina. Her teaching career has spanned all grade levels K-12 at private, charter, and public schools including Mounds Park Academy in St. Paul and St. Croix Preparatory Academy in Stillwater. Michelle attended St. Olaf College and received a Bachelor of Music degree in both Church Music/Organ Performance and Music Education and she attended the University of Notre Dame and received a Master of Music degree in Sacred Music/Organ Performance. Later she would complete all but her thesis for

the Master of Arts degree in Music Education at the University of St. Thomas. Michelle's talents and passion for playing piano, organ, and directing have allowed her to serve churches such as the Cathedral of St. Paul, Gethsemane Lutheran- Hopkins, Lake of the Isles Lutheran- Minneapolis, Mount Calvary Lutheran-Excelsior, and Minnetonka United Methodist. Michelle is an active member of the American Choral Directors Association of Minnesota (ACDA) and is accompanist for many ACDA events/honor choirs as well as the MMEA All-State Treble Choir. Michelle will be the Conductor of the Minnesota ACDA 4-5-6 Honor Choir in May 2020.



Elizabeth Egger is the conductor of Concert Choir and is also the choir director at Jordan Middle School. Her Jordan singers were featured as a clinic choir for the ACDA Fall Conference in 2015 and selected to perform at the Minnesota Music Educators Association (MMEA) Midwinter Convention in 2014. She earned her MA in Music Education at the University of St. Thomas and BM summa cum laude in Vocal Performance and Music Education at the University of Minnesota. Most recently, she directed the Cherub and Chorister Choirs at Plymouth Congregational Church and the Prelude Choir with the Minneapolis Youth Chorus. A

Wisconsin native, she has held teaching and conducting positions in schools and churches in the Milwaukee area including the Milwaukee Children's Choir. She has sung professionally with The Singers-Minnesota Choral Artists, Milwaukee Choral Artists, Florentine Opera, and Skylight Music Theatre. She is an active member of the American Choral Directors Association of Minnesota (ACDA) and Minnesota Music Educators Association (MMEA).



Rachel Lucius, director of Cantabile, also teaches K-5 general music at Rahn Elementary School of Arts & Technology in the Burnsville, Savage, Eagan school district, and has an extensive background in directing children and youth choirs. Rachel's choirs have shared the stage with musical artists including The American Boychoir, Sowah Mensah, Natalie McMaster, and David Benoit. She has worked on the artistic staff of The Northfield Youth Choirs, in Northfield, MN, Camp Albemarle, the summer music program of The American Boychoir School, in Princeton, NJ, and Allegro Choral Academy, in Apple Valley, MN. Rachel will direct the MN ACDA 4-5-6 Boys Honor Choir in May of 2019. A certified Orff-Schulwerk and Kodály music educator, Rachel holds a B.A. in Vocal Music Education from

St. Olaf College, and an M.A. in Music Education from the University of St. Thomas. Additionally, she has completed three levels of graduate choral conducting with Dr. Angela Broeker at UST. Other choral professional development work includes the Westminster Choir College Conducting Institute, and a ten-day independent study with Fernando Malvar-Ruiz and The American Boychoir as well as Melissa Keylock and the Princeton Girlchoir. Most recently, Rachel and her family spent 5 months during the spring 2017 living in Finland where she studied children's choirs and music education on a Fulbright Distinguished Awards in Teaching grant. While in Finland, she studied at the University of Jyväskylä and worked closely with both the Tapiola and Vox Aurea youth choirs.



Philip Brown Philip Brown is the conductor of the **Treble Singers** and **Cantanti Singers** and is currently the director of choral activities at Bloomington Jefferson High School. He graduated summa cum laude from Bethany College (KS), majoring in K-12 music education. He later received his M.M. degree in music education from Northern Arizona University. Before arriving in Minnesota, Philip started his public school teaching in the suburbs of Denver, Colorado (Arvada West High School). He has taught at North Campus High School in White Bear Lake and Hopkins High School. Philip was honored as the 2011 ACDA-MN Young Director of the Year. He was selected as the Director of Note for Minnesota by Choral Director Magazine in 2012. In 2013 he received the VocalEssence/ACDA-MN Creative Programming Award for his repertoire philosophy and

programming. Philip was named the Bethany College Gold Award recipient for 2015 and was the Winner of the Youth Choir Conducting Division for The American Prize 2016. Philip is an active clinician and professionally affiliated with ACDA and NAfME. He will conduct the Treble Singers next February at the 2019 National ACDA Conference in Kansas City, Missouri.
